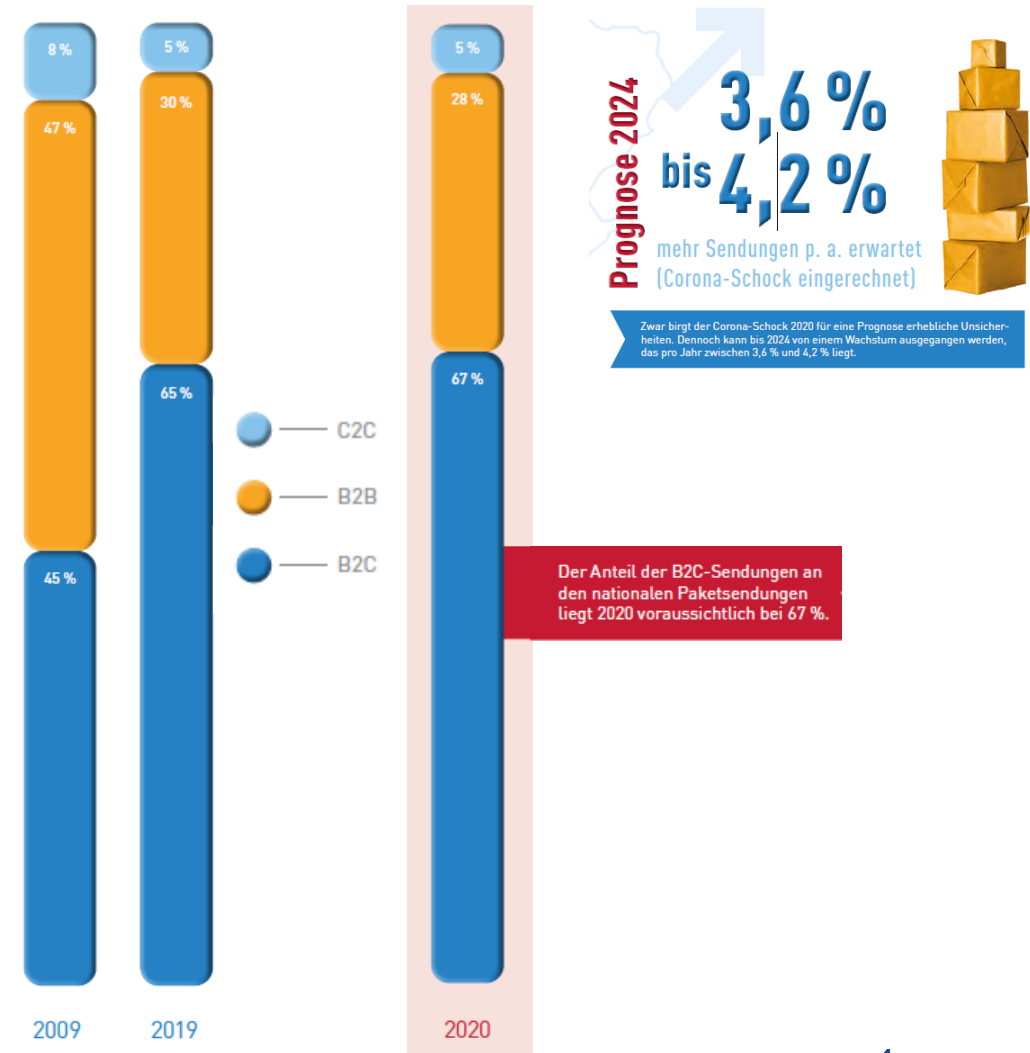
Volume of UFT to grow steadily in future

Shares and Volume

- B2C deliveries have substantially increased share of UFT
- ... and are expected to rise further in wake of Corona crisis
- currently, about 140.000 delivery vehicles in German CEP fleet alone
- at 10 percent replacement ratio and estimated growth rate, need for more than 20,000 new/additional delivery vehicles ...

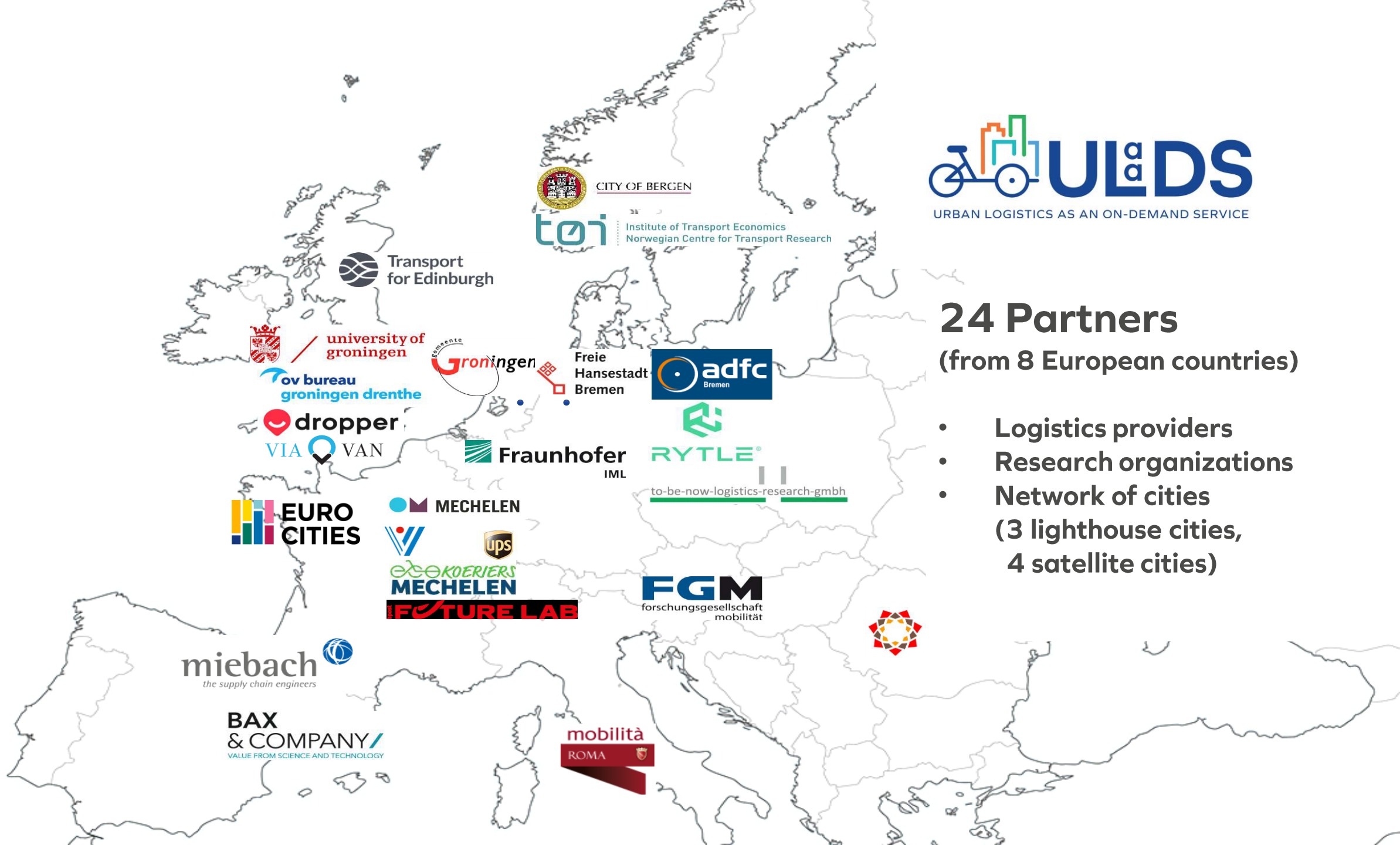

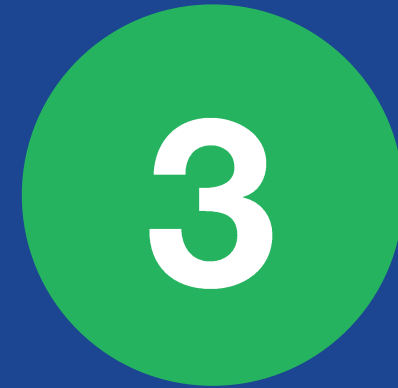

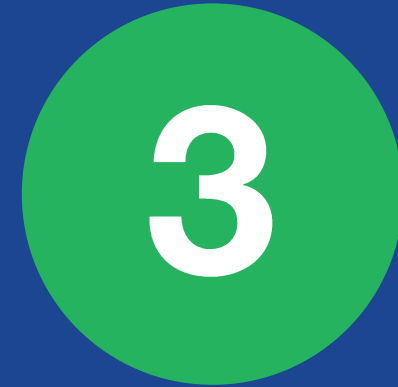
